1. Community Engagement Conference - September 19-21st - Fairmont
 - a. Who - DUI Task Forces/Prevention Specialists
 - b. Purpose - to build community engagement and bridge the gap between the state’s prevention specialists, DUI Task Forces, and law enforcement agencies in implementing and furthering their collective work toward a comprehensive community level plan for addressing substance abuse prevention strategies and efforts aimed to addressing impaired driving. .
 - c. Outcomes -
 - I. The community level participants gain an understanding of the science of prevention, utilize each other as an expert/resource.
 - II. Substance abuse prevention expert to cover the science of prevention pieces – which may include but probably not limited to: risk/protective factors, intervening variables, and the local data that collectively they can use to identify gaps/strengths, and how to use their data to target efforts to have the biggest impact/return on investment
 - III. Strengthen community engagement and collaboration – basically get out of the silos to work together and toward common goals. NCBI is potential trainer.
 - IV. Identify and bridge the prevention specialist community plans with the DUI plans so that together an achievable community plan can be put into motion upon returning to their community when the training is finished. NCBI and Prevention Expert to bring together.
