 - Policy efforts:
 - Social Host – statewide and county enabling legislation – DUI Task Forces are likely going to step up on this.
 - Funding compliance checks – this would be a legislative piece to strengthen serving training laws.
 - Strategy to curb second hand sales – strategy needed.
 - Minor In Possession consequences and required MIP education – identifying an evidence based curriculum (ie. Prime for Life) and get this into the works for implementation.
 - Public Education:
 - Above the Influence – local preventionists launching with youth through Town Halls.
 - Talk, They Hear You – Goal to have this moving in Spring 2014 – Governor statement in May focused on parents.
 - Press Opportunities – as they arise- typically with emerging substances – right now prescription drugs.
 - Youth Involvement:
 - Develop a strategy to have a youth council – partner with MBCC/JJC and OP, and others, to develop work plan to implement; Governor led – focus on safe, healthy, successful youth.
 - ACE informed strategy:
 - PRC taking a role in sorting this out within DPHHS; Childwise; other stakeholders and bridging efforts.
